**Abstract:** The Undergraduate Research Journal of History is the fourth student publication at Indiana University South Bend and was originally the idea of Dr. Lisa Zwicker, Professor of History. The premiere issue was published during the 2009-2010 academic year and included nine papers. The journal staff is entirely made up of students, who make all the decisions about content, design and publication. Like the other student journals on the IU South Bend Campus, each annual issue may have an entirely different look and feel reflecting the student staff and authors involved in the process.

**Scope and Content Note:** The IUSB Undergraduate Research Journal of History is arranged chronologically dating from 2010 to the present.
